Curatorial Prospectus and Guidelines

The Museum Studios Gallery is an approximately 400 square foot exhibition space located in Burlingame at 1777 California Drive. The Gallery is part of the Peninsula Museum of Art with twenty-nine studio artists. The Gallery exhibits work from in-house studio artists as well as external artists. All forms of visual art are encouraged including new media and installations.

The Gallery's exhibits are selected from proposals submitted to the Gallery Committee. Visiting exhibition artists/curators help us ensure a broad, balanced and varied exhibition schedule. Previous curatorial experience is not necessary.

Exhibition Proposals should be submitted via email to gallery@peninsulaartinstitute.org and must include:

- Museum Studios Gallery Application
- Curator's Statement addressing the exhibition concept
- Resumes or biographies of all participating artists/curators
- 10 digital images (5 x 7 inches, 300 dpi, jpeg format) noting artist, title, size, medium
- Outline of Outreach Events if applicable (e.g. reception, demonstration, workshop, literary event, or performance)

The Museum Studios Gallery does not charge a fee but requests a contribution of 30% of sales from exhibits. Limited installation and reception assistance is provided. Shipping, reception and other costs are the responsibility of the exhibiting artists.
